

## **W. L. Hindermann**



Mr. Hindermann made outstanding contributions to the asphalt industry as a foremost leader and advocate of Full-Depth asphalt pavement design and construction. He has written several papers on the subject, and his work led to Full-Depth being included in the famed AASHO Road Test. His work directly resulted in the acceptance and implementation of this method, world-wide. Following his retirement from the Institute in 1970, Mr. Hindermann lectured to select groups of engineers in Europe, and conducted eight-day seminars at the universities of Durban, Capetown, Johannesburg, and Salisbury, in South Africa. His career, which included 22 years with the Minnesota Department of Highways and 19 years with the Institute, has been almost entirely devoted to the proper and innovative use of asphalt.
