Dr. Stanko, a native of Pueblo, Colorado, has long been a respected authority on asphalt whose expertise has been in great demand throughout the Western states. His work with the Institute was toward development of Deep-Strength and Full-Depth asphalt pavements, leading to endorsement and adoption of these paving methods by many state, county and city engineers and authorities. In the area of roofing, too, his work pioneered the use of asphalt in widespread fashion, backed by research in which he invariably took the lead. Asphalt emulsions and slurry sealing techniques are other areas in which his expertise promoted increasing use of these materials. His early career was as Director of Research for the Flintkote Company, and he has been a consultant to other organizations, including the Natomas Corporation and Western Hydrofuels, Inc.
