

## Ward K. Parr



Mr. Parr has had a distinguished career as researcher, educator and author. From 1933 to 1955 he was employed by the Michigan State Highway Department, eventually becoming Director of the state's highway testing laboratory. In 1955 he was appointed an associate professor at the University of Michigan's College of Engineering, and during this time he served as consultant to the Michigan State Highway Department, the Ontario Department of Highways, and the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission. He was Vice President of the Chicago Testing Laboratory from 1964 until retiring in 1977. He has been active in the Association of Asphalt Paving Technologists since 1943, serving as its Executive

Secretary from 1948 to 1964, as Vice President in 1970 and 1971, and as President of its Board of Directors in 1972. He has written many papers on asphalt technology, edited volumes 18 through 38 of the Association's annual proceedings, and has served as Secretary of the 1962, 1967, and 1972 International Conferences on the Structural Design of Asphalt Pavements.
